

Attention all 4th Grade Parents!

Now is the time for you to encourage your student to sign up for the **2009-10 elementary school Beginning Band Program!**
Rising 5th graders now have the opportunity to take beginning band!

Here are some Frequently Asked Questions about band.

- Can I do 5th grade Honor Choir and still take band class? YES! 5th Grade Elementary Beginning Band and Choir do not conflict. They are offered at separate times.
- Can I play sports and still be in the band? YES! Band is offered during the school day. Many beginning band students play football, baseball, basketball, soccer and cheer.
- Does beginning band practice over the summer? No. Only members of the Dorman marching band have summer practices.
- How do I decide which band instrument to play? Band is taught by experienced professional musicians. They help place each student on the instruments. Students are encouraged to pick 2 or 3 instruments that they are most interested in.
- When does band start? Directors will help place you on an instrument on the band instrument placement nights. They are May 12th (Fairforest MS), May 14th (Gable), May 19th (Freshman Campus) and May 21st (Dawkins) in each Band Room from 5-9 PM. Students may attend any of the nights regardless of the elementary school they attend.
