# Dorman Marching Cavalier Volunteer Committees

**Check those committees below that you would like to be on.**

**Pit Crew** – Assists the band with equipment for performances, including loading/unloading, setting up/breaking down and pushing on/off the field. *If you can drive a truck, drive a gator, pull or push carts, don't mind a little manual labor, consider the Pit Crew committee.*

**Hospitality** – Organizes and assists with food preparation for meals & snacks for the band before or after competitions or any other event in which directors request meals, usually a simple quick meal for lunch or dinner depending on time of competition. *If you enjoy planning a meal or event, consider the Hospitality committee.*

**Props** – Build and decorate props for band shows. *If you are creative or artistic, can build or design, consider the Props committee.*

**Chaperones** – Chaperones band during competitions, home games, away games, etc. See Chaperone Responsibilities for Dorman Marching Band for more details. *If you want to get to know the band members, enjoy spending time with teenagers and supervising them, are available for games on Friday nights and all day on Saturday competitions, consider the Chaperone committee.*

**Ways & Means** – Organizes and supervises fund raising events – could include yard sale, fruit sales, candy sales, coupon book sales, band paraphernalia, etc. *If you are organized and enjoy coordinating events, consider the Ways & Means committee.*

**Public Relations** – Contacts media about events & awards, take photographs and videos, and coordinate updates to band booster web site. *If you enjoy photography, videotaping or working with the media, consider the Public Relations committee.*

**Uniforms** – Helps with assigning, fitting, altering (hemming of pants), and washing of uniforms. Also helps with selling of gloves & shoes to complete the uniform. *If you can sew and enjoy working with the students, consider the Uniform committee.*

**Hydration** – Ensures that coolers are filled with water & clear Gatorade for all football games, and competitions. Provide water & Gatorade for after school rehearsals Percussion/Guard only 3:50 – 5:40 M, full band 3:50 – 6:40 T/Th. *If you want to make sure the kids stay hydrated and are free in the afternoons, consider the hydration committee.*

**Section Parents** – work with hospitality committee when your section is responsible for snacks or baked goods, work with uniform committee to coordinate washing of each sections uniforms, work with student section leaders to coordinate section sweatshirts.
